**Fairfield County Auditor Receives TechCred Grant**

**Lancaster, Ohio** – The Fairfield County Auditor recently received a “TechCred” grant from the state of Ohio for employees to obtain technical credentials. The state program is designed to improve workforce knowledge in Ohio, no matter what industry the employees are working in because technology is having an impact on businesses throughout the state.

“TechCred helps employees learn new skills needed for our technology-infused economy. At the County Auditor’s Office, there will be multiple, new credentials earned in 2025 based on the grant,” stated County Auditor, Dr. Carri L. Brown.

The technical credentials include versions of Microsoft Excel, 365, Transact-SQL, and OneNote. The credentials will support the roles of financial analysts, settlements officers, payroll officers, appraisers, and trainers. Training will be completed online. The grant will provide reimbursements to the county of more than proximately \$10,000.

“We appreciate how the state is helping us provide excellent coaching and development for our team members,” added Brown.
