RM 39	938.85	Chiseled cross in top of headwall of 72-inch culvert under Old Millersport Road for Ewing Run Lateral.
RM 40	870.20	Chiseled cross in northeast wingwall of Valley View Road bridge over Pleasant Run.
RM 41	884.69	Chiseled cross in northeast wingwall of Mud House Road bridge over Pleasant Run.
RM 42	891.81	Chiseled cross in northeast wingwall of Coonpath Road culvert at Pleasant Run.
RM 43	913.97	Chiseled cross on southwest Wingwall of Beatty Road bridge over Pleasant Run.
RM 44	900.91	Chiseled cross in top of northeast wingwall of Lake Road bridge over Tributary H.

NOTES TO USER

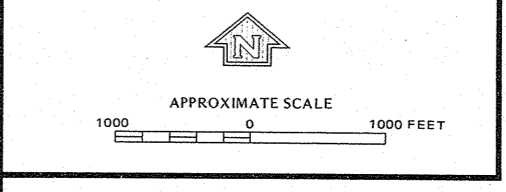
This map is for use in administering the National Flood Insurance Program. It does not necessarily identify all areas subject to flooding, particularly from local drainage sources of small size or all planimetric features outside Special Flood Hazard Areas.

Boundaries of the floodways were computed at cross sections and interpolated between cross sections. The floodways were based on hydraulic considerations with regard to requirements of the Federal Emergency Management Agency.

Floodway widths in some areas may be too narrow to show to scale. Refer to Floodway Data Table where floodway width is shown at 1/20 inch.

Corporate limits shown are current as of the date of this map. The user should contact appropriate community officials to determine if corporate limits have changed subsequent to the issuance of this map.
