REFERENCE MARK	ELEVATION FEET (NGVD)	DESCRIPTION OF LOCATION
RM 45	877.14	Chiseled triangle on the southwest upstream wingwall of Beck's Knob Rd bridge over Hunters Run.
RM 46	862.09	Chiseled square on corner of southeast wingwall of Crumley Road bridge over Hunters Run.
RM 47	860.60	Chiseled square on the southeast corner of U.S. Route 22 bridge over Hunters Run, approximately 0.5 mile east of Cemetery Road.
RM 48	844.55	Chiseled square on top of southeast abutment of Conrail bridge over Hunters Run.
RM 49	803.13	Chiseled cross in northeast abutment of U.S. Route 33 northbound bridge over the Hocking River.

**NOTES TO USER**

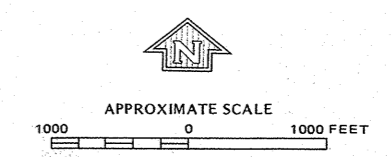
This map is for use in administering the National Flood Insurance Program; it does not necessarily identify all areas subject to flooding, particularly from local drainage sources of small size, or all planimetric features outside Special Flood Hazard Areas.

Boundaries of the floodways were computed at cross sections and interpolated between cross sections. The floodways were based on hydraulic considerations with regard to requirements of the Federal Emergency Management Agency.

Floodway widths in some areas may be too narrow to show to scale. Refer to Floodway Data Table where Floodway width is shown at 1/20 inch.

Corporate limits shown are current as of the date of this map. The user should contact appropriate community officials to determine if corporate limits have changed subsequent to the issuance of this map.
