

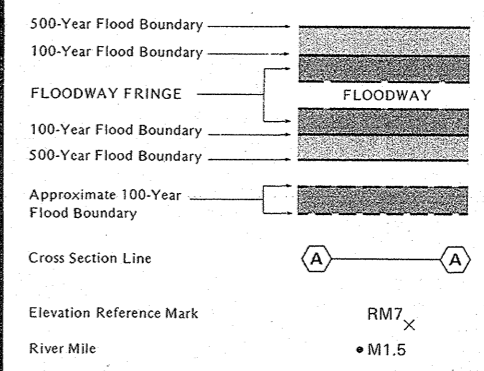

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**ELEVATION REFERENCE MARKS**

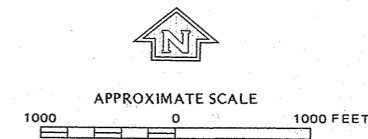
REFERENCE MARK	ELEVATION FEET (NGVD)	DESCRIPTION OF LOCATION
RM 50	793.96	Chiseled cross painted yellow, on southeast abutment of northbound lane of U.S. Route 33 bridge over the Hocking River.
RM 51	796.84	Chiseled cross painted yellow in southwest abutment of Sugar Grove Road bridge over Pleasant Run.
RM 52	808.47	Chiseled cross painted yellow in wingwall of Bauman Hill Road over Pleasant Run.
RM 53	814.82	Mine dolly spike driven into east side of OPCO Pole No. 935B4/7 on west side of Sugar Grove Road at intersection of Bauman Hill Road.
RM 54	828.50	Mine dolly spike in side of OPCO pole No. 935-C-4-34, on east side of Quarry Road, approximately 300 feet north of intersection with Duffy Road.
RM 55	851.60	Chiseled cross in southeast wingwall of Wheeling Road bridge over Pleasant Run.
RM 56	823.69	U.S. Geological Survey standard tablet stamped "190 SC 1959 824" in southwest abutment of small bridge over Raccoon Run near the intersection of Duffy and Lake Roads.

**NOTES TO USER**

This map is for use in administering the National Flood Insurance Program. It does not necessarily identify all areas subject to flooding, particularly from local drainage sources of small size, or all planimetric features outside Special Flood Hazard Areas. Boundaries of the floodways were computed at cross sections and interpolated between cross sections. The floodways were based on hydraulic considerations with regard to requirements of the Federal Emergency Management Agency. Floodway widths in some areas may be too narrow to show to scale. Refer to Floodway Data Table where floodway width is shown at 1/20 inch. Corporate limits shown are current as of the date of this map. The user should contact appropriate community officials to determine if corporate limits have changed subsequent to the issuance of this map.
