NOTES TO USER

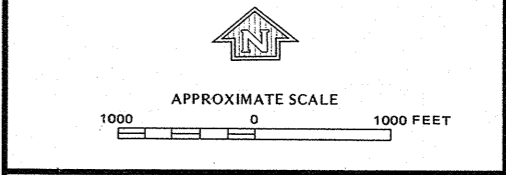
This map is for use in administering the National Flood Insurance Program. It does not necessarily identify all areas subject to flooding, particularly from local drainage sources of small size, or all planimetric features outside Special Flood Hazard Areas.

Boundaries of the floodways were computed at cross sections and interpolated between cross sections. The floodways were based on hydraulic considerations with regard to requirements of the Federal Emergency Management Agency.

Floodway widths in some areas may be too narrow to show to scale. Refer to Floodway Data Table where floodway width is shown at 120 inch.

Corporate limits shown are current as of the date of this map. The user should contact appropriate community officials to determine if corporate limits have changed subsequent to the issuance of this map.

REFERENCE MARK	ELEVATION FEET (NGVD)	DESCRIPTION OF LOCATION
RM 58	760.78	Chiseled cross in third step of northeast wingwall of CSX Railroad System bridge over Hocking River.
RM 59	768.18	Chiseled cross in southeast abutment of Sharp Road (County Route 65) bridge over Hocking River.
RM 60	777.42	Chiseled cross painted yellow in southeast abutment of U.S. Route 33 northbound bridge over the Hocking River, north of Sugar Grove.
RM 61	783.05	Chiseled cross painted red on northwest wingwall of County Route 63 bridge over Hocking River.
RM 62	786.49	U.S. Geological Survey standard tablet stamped "202 SC 1959 786" in step to house, 120 feet north of intersection of County Route 63 and Chicken Coop Hill Road.
RM 63	771.51	Chiseled square on top of southeast wingwall of County Route 63 bridge over Tributary B.
